

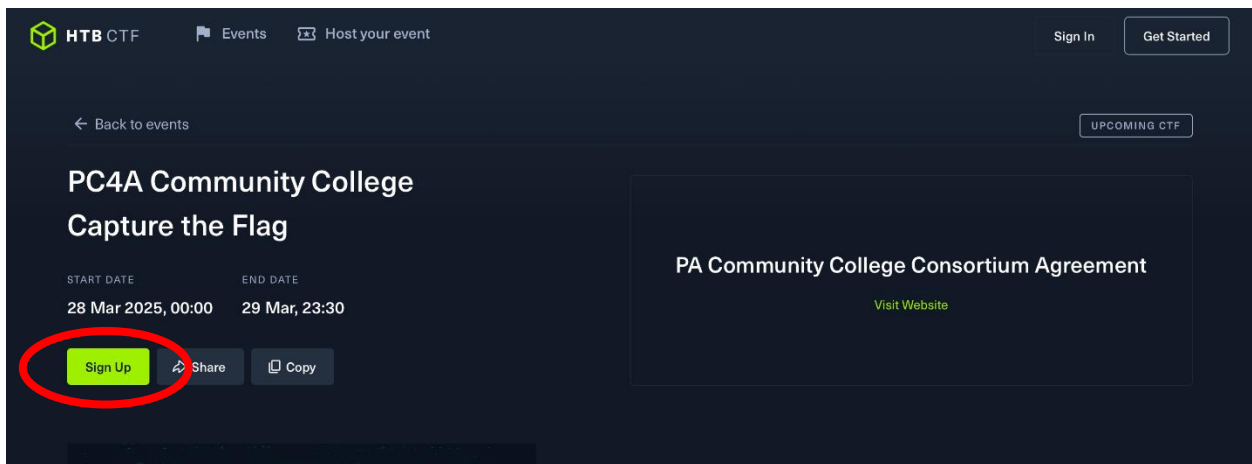
PC4A Capture the Flag Registration Tutorial

First Steps

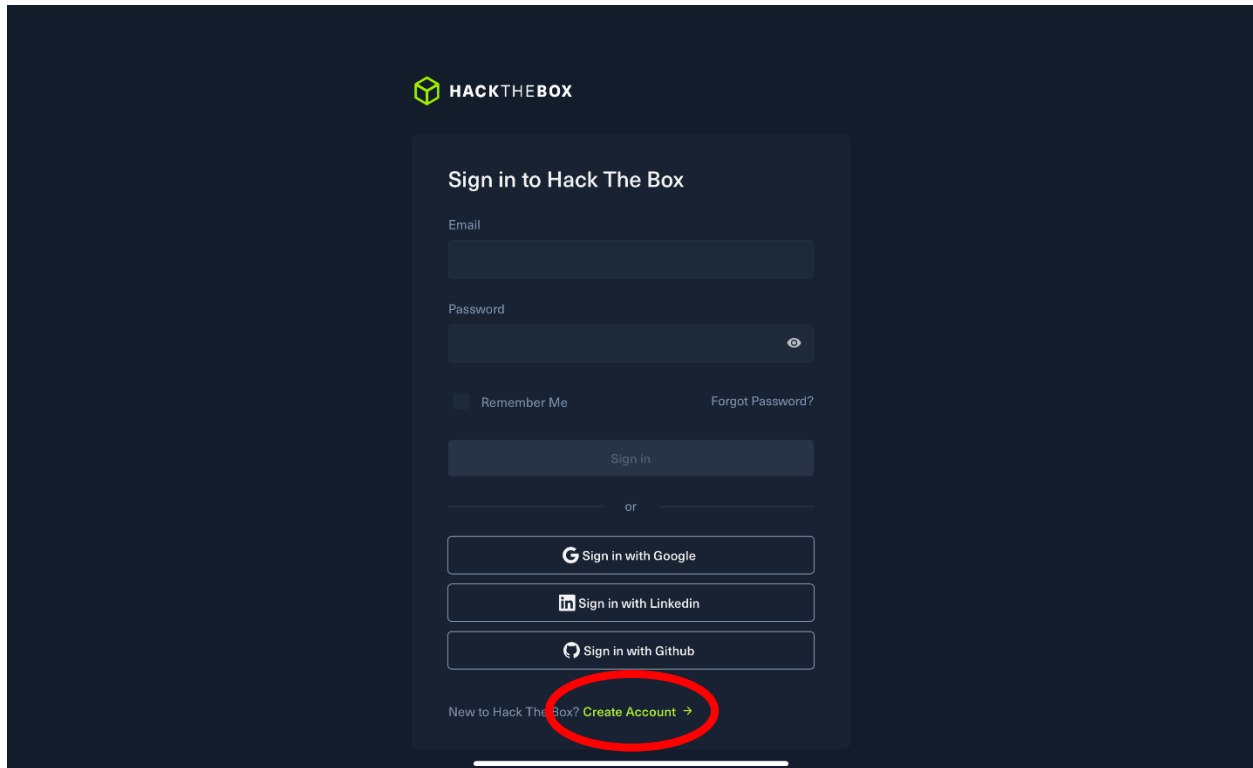
1. Select a classmate to be the team leader. This person is responsible for creating the team and accepting team mate requests.

Creating a Hack the Box Account

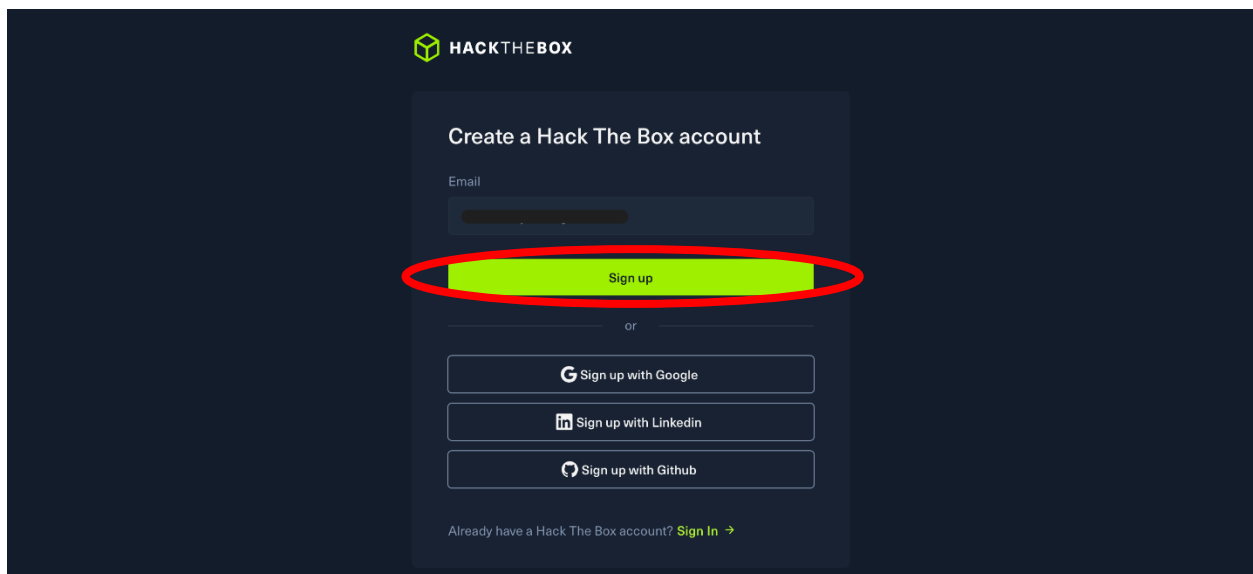
1. Visit <https://ctf.hackthebox.com/event/details/pc4a-community-college-capture-the-flag-2128> and click **Sign Up**.




2. Click **Create Account**.


Registering for the CTF Competition

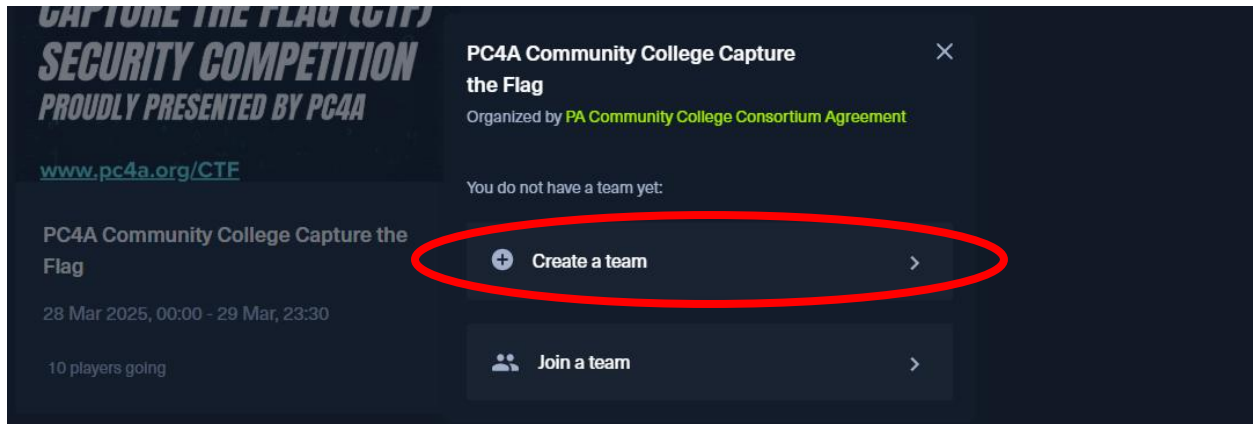

4. Follow the instructions to either [create a team](#), [or join a team](#).



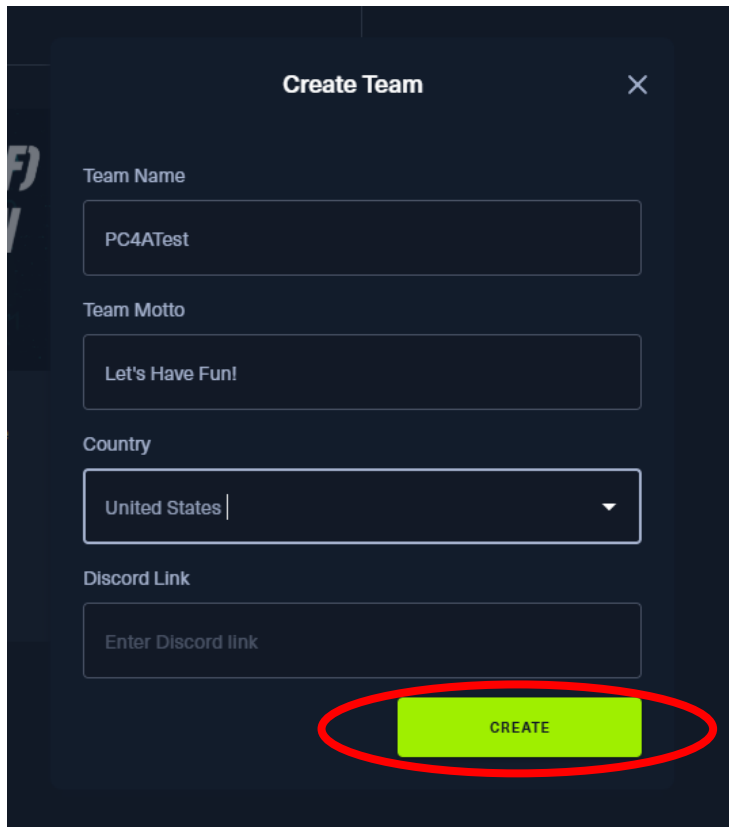

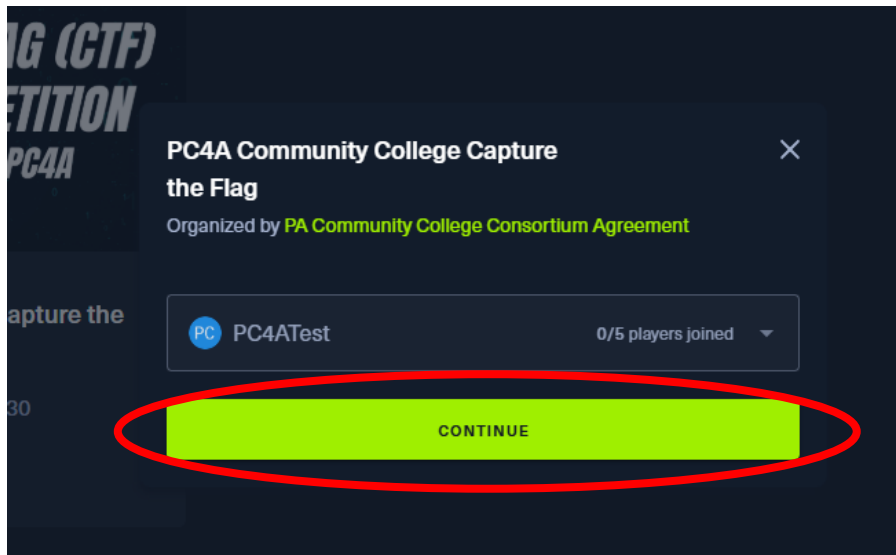
Creating a Team

1. Click on **Create Team**

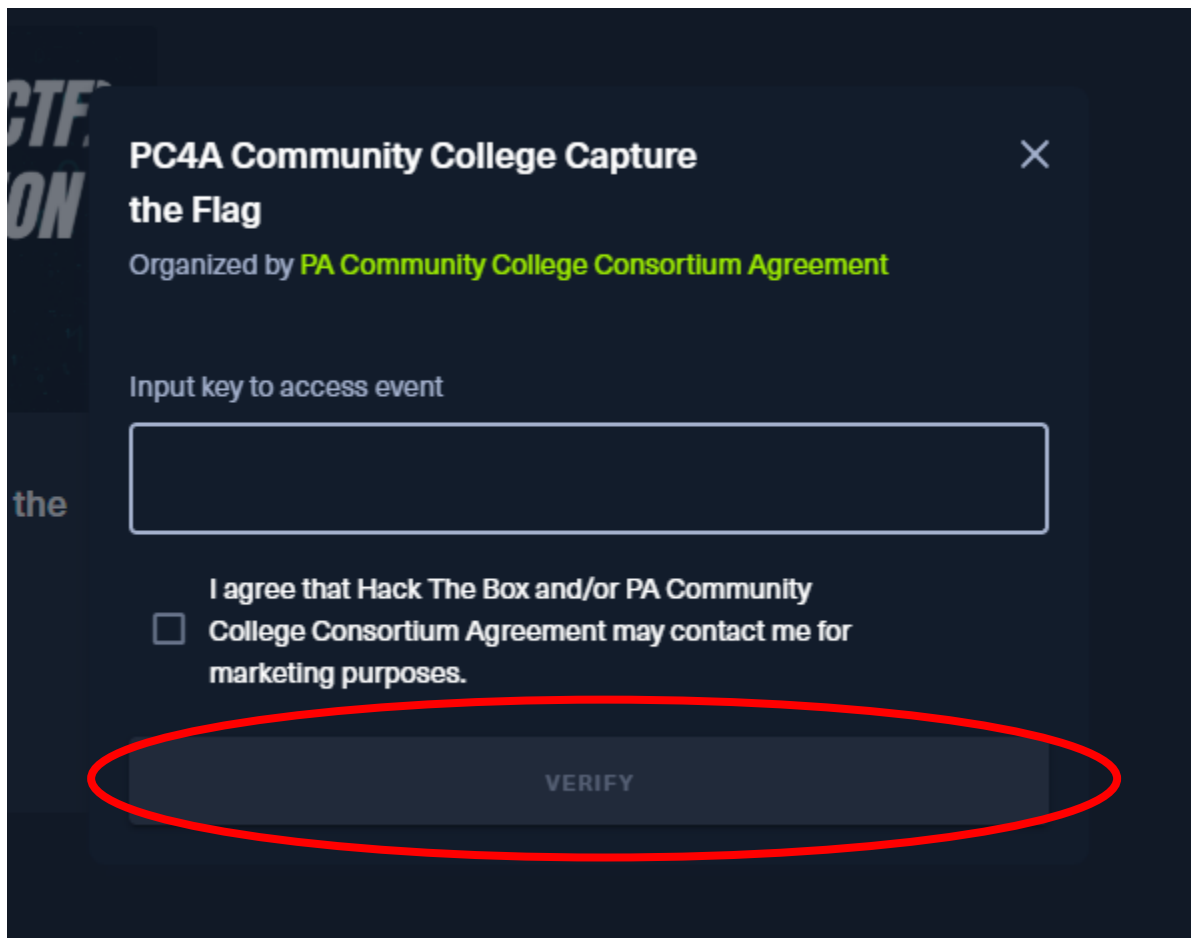


2. Enter team details and click **Create** and then **Continue**

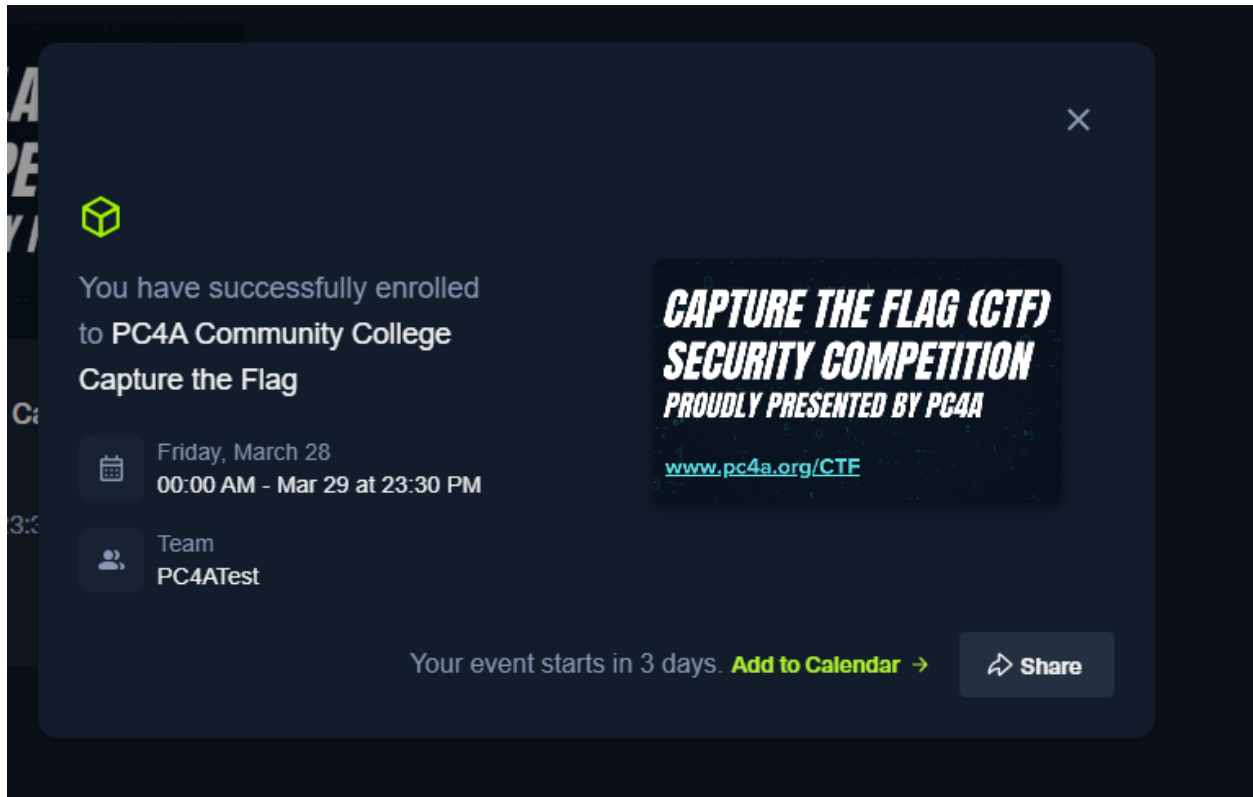




3. If you haven't already requested the event password, complete the online form at <https://form.jotform.com/250463263974058> and the password will be emailed to you.
4. Enter the event password and click **Verify**

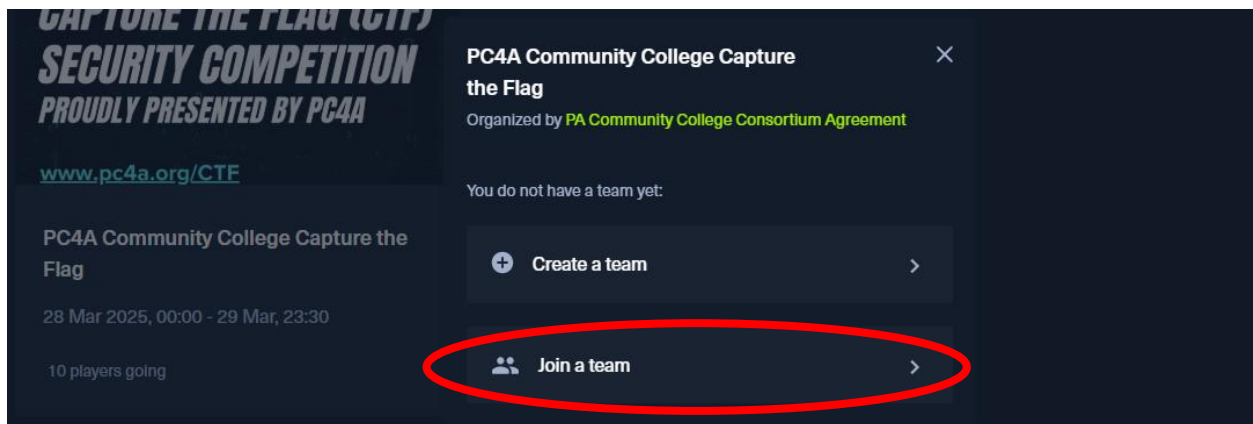


5. You will see the following screen confirming your registration.

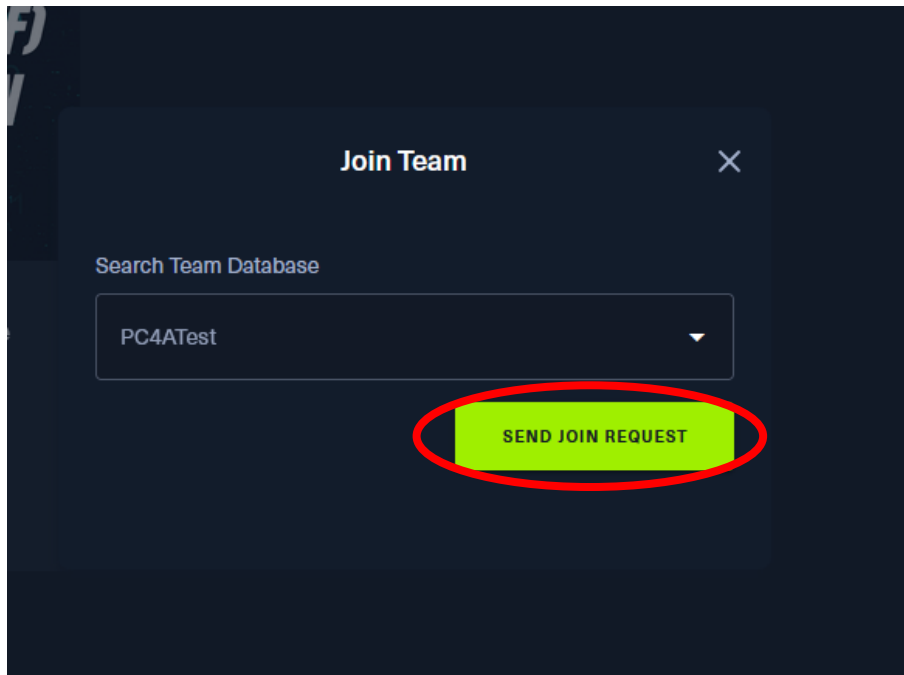


Joining a Team

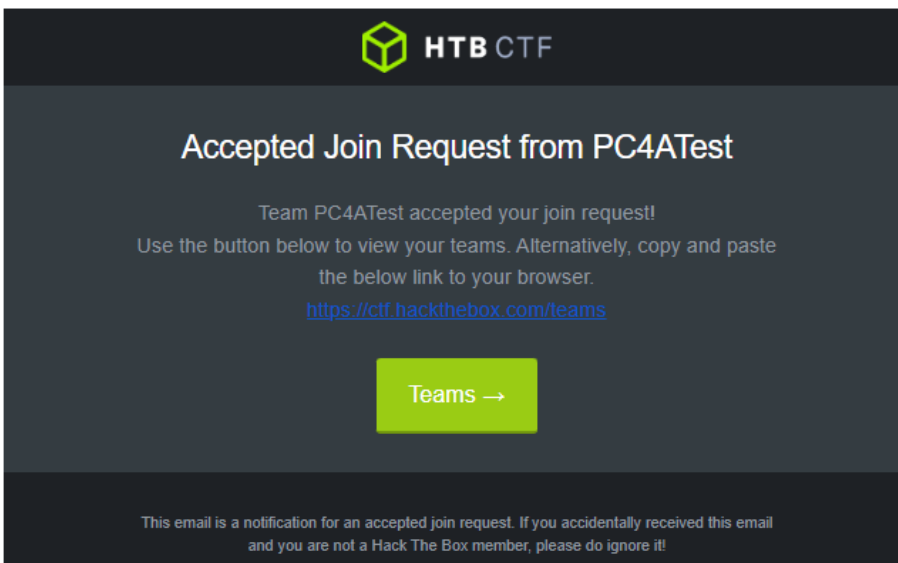
1. Click on **Join a Team**



2. Search for your team name in the search box. You will need the exact spelling. Once your team is found, click on **Send Join Request**

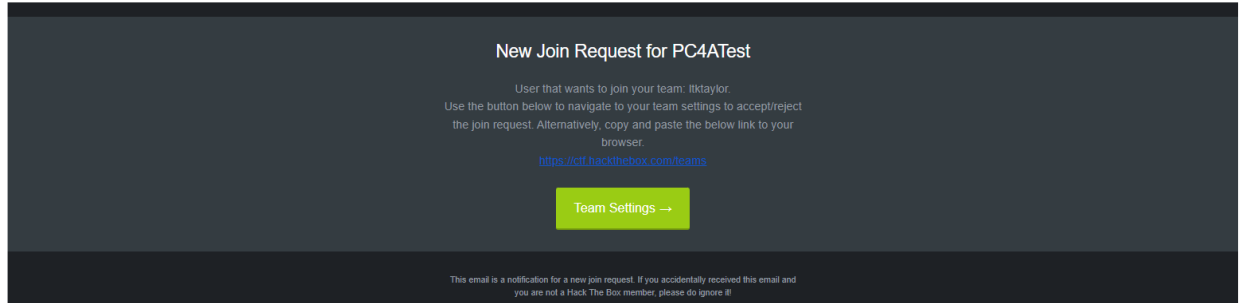


3. Once your Team Leader has accepted your request, you will receive an email confirming your acceptance.

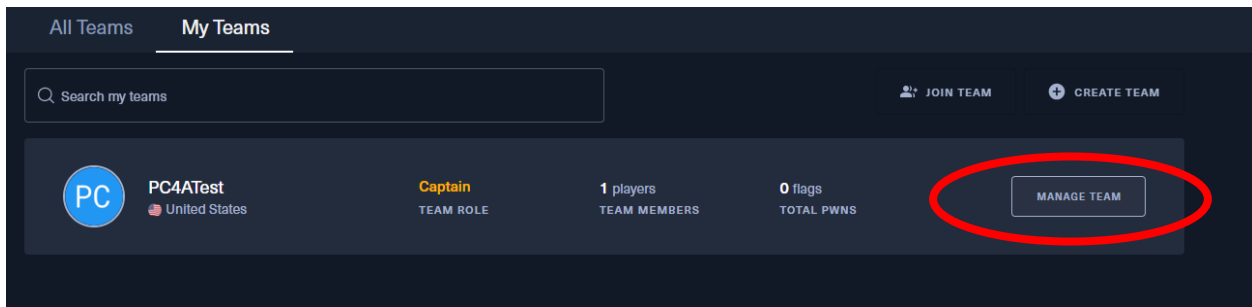


Accepting Teammates

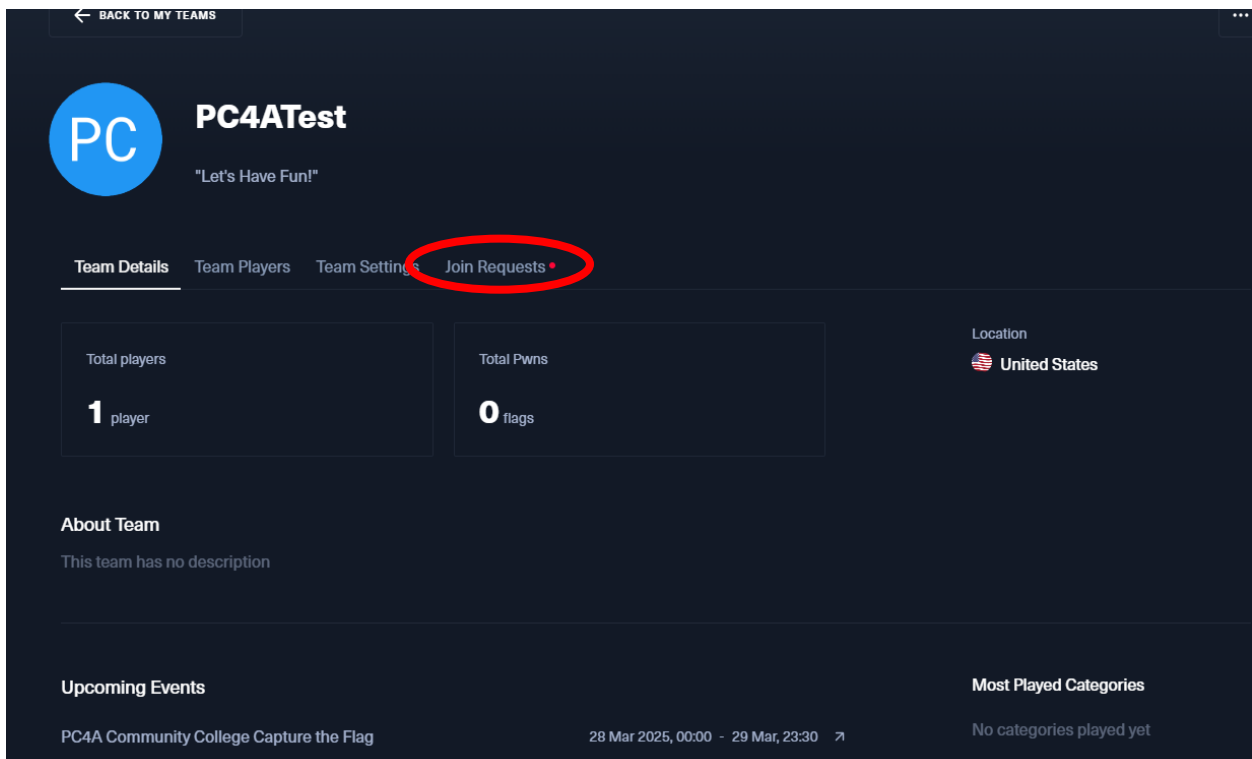
1. You will be notified via email when a teammate requests to join your team. You can click on the link in the email to manage requests.




2. Click on **Manage Team**
